GROUP SCRIPTURE READING:

Hebrews 10:5&10 “Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but **a body hast thou prepared me...**¹⁰ By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of **the body of Jesus Christ once for all.**”

1 Peter 1:19-20 “But with the precious blood of Christ, **as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:** Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but **was manifest in these last times for you.**”

1. INTRODUCTION: Every year on Nissan 10, God commanded each family to select a lamb for Passover, and on Nissan 10 of 30 AD, Jesus rode into Jerusalem as the Lamb of God, the Messiah, the chosen lamb, God manifest in flesh, to save His people from their sins, for He as God, came to shed His own blood, once for all.

2. NISSAN 10 ON THE HEBREW CALENDAR IS THE DAY THAT LAMBS WERE CHOSEN FOR THE PASSOVER.

Exodus 12:2-6 "This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you. In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house... ⁵Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year.. ⁶And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.



1 Peter 1:19-20 "But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you."

John 1:29 "...John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world."

John 10:17-18 "Therefore does my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. ¹⁸No man takes it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again...."

On the 10th day of Nissan in the 3790th year of the Hebrew Calendar; it was Sabbath March 30, of 30 AD. As Jesus rode into Jerusalem, it was at the time of day when each household was to select a spotless lamb to care for in their home until the slaying of the lambs just before sunset on Nissan 14 - on a Wednesday that year. This fluffy lamb on our table, reminds us that Jesus came into Jerusalem that day knowing that He would be slain as the Passover Lamb. God wants us, His people, to understand that His Son was innocent and loved like a sweet baby Passover lamb, and that Jesus came to die for you!

Hebrews 10:5&10 "Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me...¹⁰ By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."

3. NISSAN 10 BEGINS HOLY WEEK, WHEN JESUS RODE INTO JERUSALEM AS KING OF ISRAEL, THE CHOSEN LAMB OF GOD, JUST AS THE SCRIPTURES FORETOLD.

Zechariah 9:9 “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon a donkey, and upon a colt the foal of a donkey.”

Leviticus 23:40 “And ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before the LORD your God....”

The only Savior God of Heaven, the King of Heaven, became a man to die for us, and forever we too, rejoice and bow before Him!

Matthew 21:8-9 “And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way. ⁹And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest!”




It was the custom from time of old to honor kings, loudly exclaiming “Hosanna! Hosanna! Meaning “God save us!” They rejoiced before God waving palm branches, to honor Jesus, receiving Him as their promised King and Redeemer of Israel! Let’s each take a palm branch (pass out palms), and praise our Savior and King, the Lord Jesus, just like the Jewish people who lined the streets singing as they waved palm branches to honor their King! (*Wave Palm Branches as you walk around the room singing ‘Hosannah in the Highest!’*)

But how did the Jewish people know that Jesus was the King of Heaven who came to save them? Where did they learn that?

4. WHY DID THE JEWISH PEOPLE SHOUT THE EXPRESSION OF PRAISE TO GOD, HOSANNA, TO JESUS? HOW DID THEY KNOW THAT JESUS WAS GOD?

The Jewish people who lined the streets waved palm branches, praising Jesus, worshipped Him as the Messiah who came to save them! But how did the Jewish people know that Jesus was the God of Heaven who came to save them? Where did they learn that?



Isaiah 43:10-12 “*Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. 11. I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour.*” ¹²*I have declared, ... ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, that I am God.*”

God spoke His word, to the prophet Isaiah as both Everlasting Father and servant. Israel was looking for a child to be born who was God Himself, the Messiah, whose name would be called the Everlasting Father. God said there would never be another Savior formed who was not He Himself, the same LORD who spoke it. They saw hundreds of Messianic prophecies fulfilled in Jesus, **so they worshipped Him as the God who had spoken these things.**

Isaiah 43:1 “*For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.*”

The **LORD God of Israel proclaimed Himself** to be **both Savior and chosen servant yet to come.** He said there was no God ever before Him, nor would any other person ever be formed after Him to come beside Him! **Jesus was declared to be that same LORD at His birth** because He is the invisible Spirit of the Father God Himself begotten in flesh as the Son of God: Jesus is who He claimed to be. The Jewish people who shouted Hosanna to Jesus, were loudly worshipping their God who Isaiah prophesied would come as a child to save them!

5. ISAIAH PROPHESED THAT THE SCRIBES WOULD CAUSE GOD'S PEOPLE TO FORGET HIS NAME, THAT WOULD BE RESTORED BY THE MOUTH OF THE LORD.

*Jeremiah 23:26-27 How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, **they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart;** ²⁷**Which think to cause my people to forget my name** by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal."*

*Jeremiah 8:8 "How do ye say, We are wise, and the law of the LORD is with us? **the pen of the scribes is in vain.**"*

God's name was long forgotten by His people because they had worshipped the god's of Babylon until scribes replaced God's name with the name of the Baal moon god 'Yahreah' (Yahweh) a Calf. Another way causing God's people to forget His name happened when the scribes would write "Adonai" above God's name to say instead, so they would not speak God's name in vain, then later scribes interpolated the vowels to make up the name 'Jehovah'. This is why God said He would be called by a new name, that God would come to restore by His own mouth!

*Isaiah 62:1-2 "For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth as brightness, and **the salvation** (Hebrew-yeshua) thereof as a lamp that burneth. **And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness,** and all the kings thy glory: **and thou shalt be called by a new name,** **which the mouth of the LORD shall name.**"*

*Luke 2:21 And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, **his name was called JESUS, which was named of the angel** before he was conceived in the womb."*

Isaiah 62:1-2 prophesied that the Gentiles would see God's righteousness and His name would be restored by the mouth of the Lord, which was fulfilled by the angel Gabriel, through whom God named His son. The name of JESUS in any language carries such power, because the name God gave to His Son is His own sacred memorial name that means 'I AM!'

6. THE PEOPLE SHOUTED HOSANNA 'JESUS SAVE US' BECAUSE ONLY GOD'S OWN NAME CAN SAVE.

How is it that Iesous is God's name? The Hebrew disciples recognized the name Mary gave to her son because Hebrew scholars had been reading from the Tora translated into the Greek Septuagint from the 2nd and 3rd century before Jesus Christ was born. **Every time the word salvation was in read in the Septuagint, is was written Iesous**, so they had for a long time been looking for 'Iesous' (Salvation) to come to Israel! God gave His Son His own name just as He said, but written in Greek letters. Jews of the Diaspora who all spoke Greek were looking for Iesous! Iesous carries the phonetic Hebrew sound of God's name, I AM, 'EhYeh Ashur EyYeh' (Yehshua) that He gave to Moses! This is why Mary was told by the angel to name her son IESOUS, JESUS because He would save God's people from their sins; JESUS is I AM and JESUS is salvation!

John 5:43 "I am come in my Father's name....."


*Acts 4:12 "Neither is there salvation in any other: for **there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.**"*

Jews of 30 AD had all been forced to speak Greek for 200-300 years before the coming of the Messiah. When the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary, telling her to name her baby Iesous, she knew that Iesous meant Salvation. The Hebrew people **recognized the name of God**, and they lined the streets to worship 'Iesous', Salvation, 'Yeshuah' their Messiah.




The Holy Place where Abraham went to sacrifice Isaac, where the Lord would be crucified, is outside the city gates of **the Holy Land of Moriah that is called Jerusalem**. On Palm Sabbath Jews from every nation were gathered together to select their lambs for the Passover, and the Lamb of God rode through the city gate.

7. THE LAND OF MORIAH BECAME JERUSALEM



The whole of Mt. Moriah is called the “Holy Place”, with Golgotha, *meaning top or summit of the skull*, being the highest summit of Mt. Moriah. The Jewish historian Josephus recognized Golgotha as the place where Abraham went to sacrifice Isaac. [Genesis 22:1-5](#) says Abraham arrived at the place God showed him in the Land of Moriah, at a flat resting place where the Temple was later built. He looked afar off, up to the

summit, then told his entourage to wait there while he went farther up to sacrifice Isaac. After 3 days Abraham returned with Isaac because God said He would provide the Lamb, wonderfully fulfilled in the fulness of time by the Lamb of God, the Messiah. When Solomon dug his quarries, you can see that a dry moat was dug that separates Golgotha from the flat part of Mt. Moriah where the Temple was later built. The tunnel that Solomon dug, where treasures are stored, goes from under the Temple mount to under Golgotha, connecting them. The city wall was built above the tunnel in that space, and this is how Golgotha came to be outside the city wall, fulfilling prophecy that the Messiah would be crucified outside the gates of the city.




8. ON PALM SABBATH JESUS SPOKE OF THE DESOLATIONS TO COME UPON THE NATION OF ISRAEL FOR THEIR ABOMINATION OF STANDING UP A CROSS TO CRUCIFY THEIR SAVIOR THE LORD OF ALL HEAVEN AND EARTH, IN 'THE HOLY PLACE' WHERE GOD PROVIDED THE LAMB.

Matthew 24:14-16 "And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. ¹⁵When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)" ¹⁶Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains.

When believing Jews saw their Messiah, God incarnate, crucified on the Mt. of 'The Holy Place' many fled to the mountains of Pela.

Matthew 23:31-36 "Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets. ³²Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers...³⁵That upon you may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth...." ³⁶Verily I say unto you, All these things shall come upon this generation."



Matthew 23:37-38 "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you that kill the prophets, and stone them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathers her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!" ³⁸Behold, your house is left unto you desolate."

The prophecy of Daniel 9:24-27 was fulfilled when the Gospel was given to the Gentiles at the house of Cornelius ending the renewal of God's 7 year covenant with those Jews who believed. The consummation of God's covenant came in 70 AD at the fall of Jerusalem, when Josephus reported they saw the dead, the 144,000 believing Jews, who lay unburied in the streets, rise to their feet and go up with the armies of heaven, Jewish War Book 6, Ch.5, P.3. But the House, the nation of unbelieving Israel, was left to them desolate even as Daniel prophesied and as Jesus said. God consummated His covenant with Israel within the generation of the disciples to whom Jesus spoke, that day on the steps of the Temple.

9. ON PALM SABBATH, THE FATHER WAS FULLY IN THE SON, SPEAKING ON THE STEPS OF THE TEMPLE.

Matthew 1:23 “Behold, a virgin shall be with child, shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.”

John 14:10 “... Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.”

John 1:12-13 “But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.”

Acts 20:28 “Take heed unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.”

Jesus told His Jewish disciples from the scriptures, that He was renewing His covenant with them, and answered their questions concerning desolations prophesied to come upon the Jewish nation, the signs to watch for before His coming, and before the end of the world.




Matthew 24:1-3 “And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple. ² And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? Verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. ³ And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? And what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?”

God had come in His Son, to reconcile His people to Himself. It was after the triumphal entry into Jerusalem, that Jesus sat on the steps of the temple with His disciples, reminding them of generations of sins committed by their fathers, of the sins they were about to commit against Him, and of the desolations that were determined by the prophets to come upon Israel because of those abominations, to come before the final end of the world.

10. DANIEL PROPHESED OF THE COMING OF THIS LORD, IN HIS PROPHECY OF 70 WEEKS OF YEARS.

After the triumphal entry into Jerusalem, Jesus sat on the steps of the temple with His disciples, recounting in [Matthew 23](#) the sins committed by their fathers against Him for generations, revealing the abomination they were about to commit, and announced that the desolations determined by the prophets were to come upon Israel because of those abominations, and would be fulfilled within the generation to whom He spoke.

[Daniel 9:24-27](#) *“Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy...27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.”*




Desolations began at the end of the 7 year covenant Jesus had renewed with the nation of Israel on the steps of temple. So as Daniel prophesied, for 7 years after Jesus was baptized, the Gospel was preached only to the Jews of Israel, but Messiah was cut off after 3 ½ years in the midst of that 70th week. Then 3 ½ years after the crucifixion, when Stephen was stoned, the Gospel was taken from the unbelieving Jews and given to the believing Gentiles at the house of Cornelius. There, the new nation of believing Jew and Gentile called Israel, was born in one day, [Acts 10](#); [1 Pet 2:9-10](#). Desolations increased in severity until all the desolations to come upon the house of Israel was fulfilled in that generation just as Jesus said [Matthew 23](#) (Within 40 years of Jesus’ proclamation, ending in the year 70 AD with the total desolation of Jerusalem, and of unbelieving Israel).

11. IN THE PROPHECY OF DANIEL, GOD GAVE HIS PEOPLE ISRAEL, 70 WEEKS OF YEARS TO:

- To finish the transgressions of Israel against God.
- To make reconciliation for their sins.
- To bring in everlasting righteousness (by the death of the Messiah on the cross).
- To seal up the vision and prophecy (until the final end).
- To anoint the most Holy (who is Jesus).
- For the Most Holy to confirm God's covenant with Israel for 1 week (7 years).
- Midweek after 3½ years, God ended daily animal sacrifice by shedding His own blood on the cross once for all sins.
- Daily sacrifices cease because of His death on the cross.
- Jesus declared Israel to be desolate for sins committed.
- The consummation of God's covenant with Israel, was determined to be poured out at the end of the 70 years after Christ's birth, when 144,000 believing Jews were called up.

John 1:23-24; 26-30 "He said, I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Esaias. ..."

²⁷ He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose. ²⁸ These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing. ²⁹ The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. ³⁰ This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me."



Jesus, the Most Holy was anointed as the Messiah on the day of His baptism by John exactly 69 prophetic weeks of years from the commandment to rebuild Jerusalem. This event began the 70th week of years prophesied by Daniel. **Jesus confirmed His covenant for one week with many thousands of Israel** who received salvation through the Gospel that was preached exclusively to them, then He was cut off mid week, and

12. OLD TESTAMENT SCRIPTURES FORETOLD THAT GOD HIMSELF WOULD COME TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE.

Luke 2:25-32 “And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel ²⁶ And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ... ²⁸ Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, ²⁹ Lord, now let thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: ³⁰ For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, ³¹ Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; ³² A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.”

The ancient Paleo Hebrew name of the Father God in modern Hebrew letters, יהוה, or in English letters 'HWH, is the same sacred name, Ehyeh-Ashur-Ehyeh, that God gave Abraham at the burning bush, and is the only name under heaven by which men can be saved. The sacred name cannot be Yahweh which was the Golden Calf idol and his goddess Asherah (Diane/Ishtar) that apostate Israel worshipped in Egypt. Ehyeh-Ashur-Ehyeh, in its shortened form is Yeshua. Yeshua, Jehsoohs and Jesus are the same name. The Yod י is a guttural sound like our J, the ancient letter 'H' Hhets ה is pronounced 'Hs', the Wa ו is pronounced 'oo', and Hs: J-Hs-OO-Hs - JESUS



Simeon had been waiting in the Temple to see the Messiah God promised was coming to bring them salvation. Yeshuah is the same name YHVH, who was known to be the I AM of the wilderness, and recognized by the Jews as the salvation name, because Yeshuah is the name of God.

Exodus 3:14-15 " And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM; and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM ('HWH), hath sent me unto you... this is MY NAME FOREVER, and this is my memorial unto all generations."

Matthew 1:21 “And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.”

God’s name, I AM, Yeshua, Jehsoohs, JESUS was given to His Son by the angel, to the virgin Mary; His name means salvation.

13. DANIEL'S 70 WEEKS PROPHECY WAS FULFILLED BY THE COMING OF MESSIAH ON PALM SABBATH TO RENEW HIS COVENANT WITH ISRAEL FOR 7 YEARS.



Matthew 10:5-6 “These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.”

The Messiah came preaching the Gospel to the house of Israel. 144,000 Jews of Israel received salvation by faith in Him!

Acts 2:41 “Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.”

Acts 4:4 “Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.”

Acts 17:10 “And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews.”


Acts 6:7 “And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.”

As Isaiah and Daniel foretold, God came to renew His covenant with Israel for 7 years, bringing salvation to them for 3 ½ years, when He was cut off for sin. The last 3 ½ years of the covenant His disciples took the light of the Gospel to the Gentiles.

Galatians 3:28-29 “There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.”

14. PARABLE STORY: SAVED FROM CERTAIN DEATH!



Most of us remember the heartwarming story of “Charlotte’s Web” about a young girl’s love for a pig named Wilbur, such a wonderful story! Fern grew up on a farm where the harsh reality of life was that the animals she loved had to be killed for food. One day Fern saw her father take an ax into the barn to kill a newborn pig because it was too small to survive on its own, but Fern saved the pig and took care of

him as her pet. The sad beginning of the story reminds me of how the Hebrew children must have felt about the Passover Lamb that came to live in their home for three days.

Those children took care of their lamb, and loved it just like Fern loved Wilbur. In the story Fern brought Wilbur into her home to save him from being killed for no fault of his own. The Hebrew children brought the lamb into their home to love, but they knew the little lamb would be killed in the end of the 3rd day in the twilight of Nissan 14, beginning the day of



Nissan 15. He would be slain for no fault of its own but for their own sins. First their dad would lay his hands on the head of the lamb and confess the sins of the family. Then that sweet little lamb sad they would be! Then the blood of the lamb would be applied to the door post of the house, so that by faith in the blood of the lamb, the judgment of death would **“PASS - OVER”** their home.

God wanted His people to see how the ugliness of sin destroys the innocence and sweetness of life, for the penalty of sin is death. But God provided the Lamb when He came as a little child in His Son, to shed His own blood to save you. The innocent lamb was a substitute until Jesus came as the Lamb of God. How wonderful but sad for Mary to know that her sweet little boy was the Messiah who would grow up to be the Lamb of God, who would shed His own blood for the sins of the world because He loves us so much!
